Advisory Desk Notes reflect recent developments in technical standards or new knowledge that designers need to be made aware of.

Some of them arise because a question is being frequently asked of the steel sector's technical advisers. They have always been recognised as essential reading for all involved in the design of constructional steelwork.

The longer technical articles cover more detailed insights into what designers need to know, often the result of legislative changes or changes to codes and standards. Topics included within the 2017 Technical Digest include; trusses, hybrid fabricated girders and an overview of new design tools available.
